The new Rendez-Vous Celestial draws its inspiration from the astonishing lightshow of the aurora borealis. Offering a view of the celestial map as seen from the northern hemisphere, this new feminine interpretation of a unique horological feature explores the full range of artistic possibilities offered by Jaeger-LeCoultre's Rare Handcrafts' workshop.

The Manufacture Jaeger-LeCoultre's watchmakers have imagined the Rendez-Vous Sonata Large to provide a discreet reminder of an upcoming rendezvous. It chimes at the appointed hour, thanks to the mysterious little star that has marked out certain models of the Rendez-Vous line since its inception and that can be moved around the dial.
