With its enamel watch dial, hand-painted lapis lazuli sky, its bezel set with sapphires and its shimmering diamonds, the Rendez-Vous Celestial makes a striking statement. Taking its inspiration from the spectacular lightshow of the aurora borealis, this jewel of creativity holds in its beating heart the Jaeger-LeCoultre 809/1 automatic movement.

A fiery temperament beneath a brightly coloured wave of pink and blue

Its generous 37.5mm dial traces the moving constellations of the stars with precision. Powered by its automatic movement, time passes in beauty with captivating hues of deep blue to intense purple, colours prized, rare and precious in the world of Haute Horlogerie. Against this backdrop suffused with shades of amethyst, the celestial map, viewed from the northern hemisphere, gracefully rotates.

From its crown of baguette cut sapphires, to the light play that reflects like a mirror, and its inviting pool of blue, pink and violet hues, the Rendez-Vous Celestial is both a piece of jewellery and a work of art, fully harnessing the inventiveness and genius of the Maison's Métiers Rares®. Under a clear sky, the dial's magical colours continue round the rim of the case, while the grey gold star remains poised at the whim of the wearer. A rendez-vous awaits.
