



AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE 76th VENICE INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL, JAEGER-LECOULTRE HONOURS THE MAJOR AWARD WINNERS

Venice, 7 September 2019 – At the closing ceremony of Venice International Film Festival this evening, Jaeger-LeCoultre recognised the winners of the Leone D'Oro award for Best Film and the Coppa Volpi awards for Best Actress and Best Actor by presenting each of them with a specially commissioned Reverso timepiece. These original pieces, created by the artisans at Jaeger-LeCoultre's manufacture in the Vallée de Joux, have each been hand-engraved with the symbol of Venice: a winged lion, and the words 'Leone D'oro' and 'Coppa Volpi'.

Todd Phillips received this year's Best Film award (Leone d'Oro) for *Joker*.

The Coppa Volpi for Best Actress has been awarded to Ariane Ascaride for her role in *Gloria Mundi*.

The Coppa Volpi for Best Actor has been awarded to Luca Marinelli for his role in *Martin Eden*.
